



Applicability of the Trusted Firmware-A (TF-A) vulnerabilities on OpenSTLinux deliveries

Overview

This security bulletin pertains to the applicability of Trusted Firmware-A (TF-A) vulnerabilities on the OpenSTLinux deliveries.

Description

The open-source Trusted Firmware-A software component is redistributed inside the OpenSTLinux deliveries. This means that the vulnerabilities reported by TrustedFirmware.org available at <https://trustedfirmware-a.readthedocs.io/en/latest/process/security.html#security-advisories> are applicable to the OpenSTLinux deliveries supporting Trusted Firmware-A.

To know if an OpenSTLinux delivery is impacted, check if the Trusted Firmware-A software version delivered is affected by the listed vulnerabilities.

The component version is detailed in:

- Docs/change-log.md file at the root of the source tree.

To fix the vulnerability, reconfigure the affected package with a corrected version of the Trusted Firmware-A component, obtained from the Trusted Firmware-A website.
